We are delighted to announce the outstanding performance of Grade XII students in the CBSE board examinations for the academic year 2023-24.


- Saksham Aggarwal and Dhruv Sharma achieved an impressive 491 out of 500 marks leading all Grade XII students to their impressive results.

The session covered essential hygiene practices, such as proper disposal of sanitary pads, the use and care of reusable pads, and the importance of washing hands.



The workshop created a safe space for students to ask questions and discuss their concerns openly, helping to clear doubts about menstruation, making them feel prepared and supported in managing their health.

Anaemia Detection Camp


